Measurements in cm

Waist	=	82 cm
Seat	=	102 cm
Body rise	=	27 cm
Inside leg	=	81 cm
Trouser bottom	=	25 cm

2. Trace out the bodice and sleeve blocks provided and draft final patterns for the blouse style sketched below.



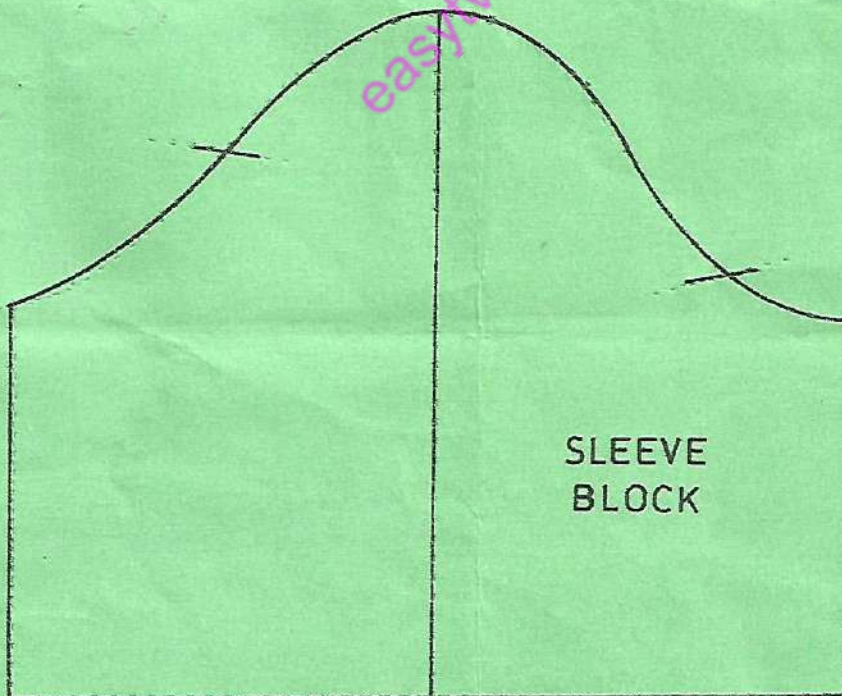
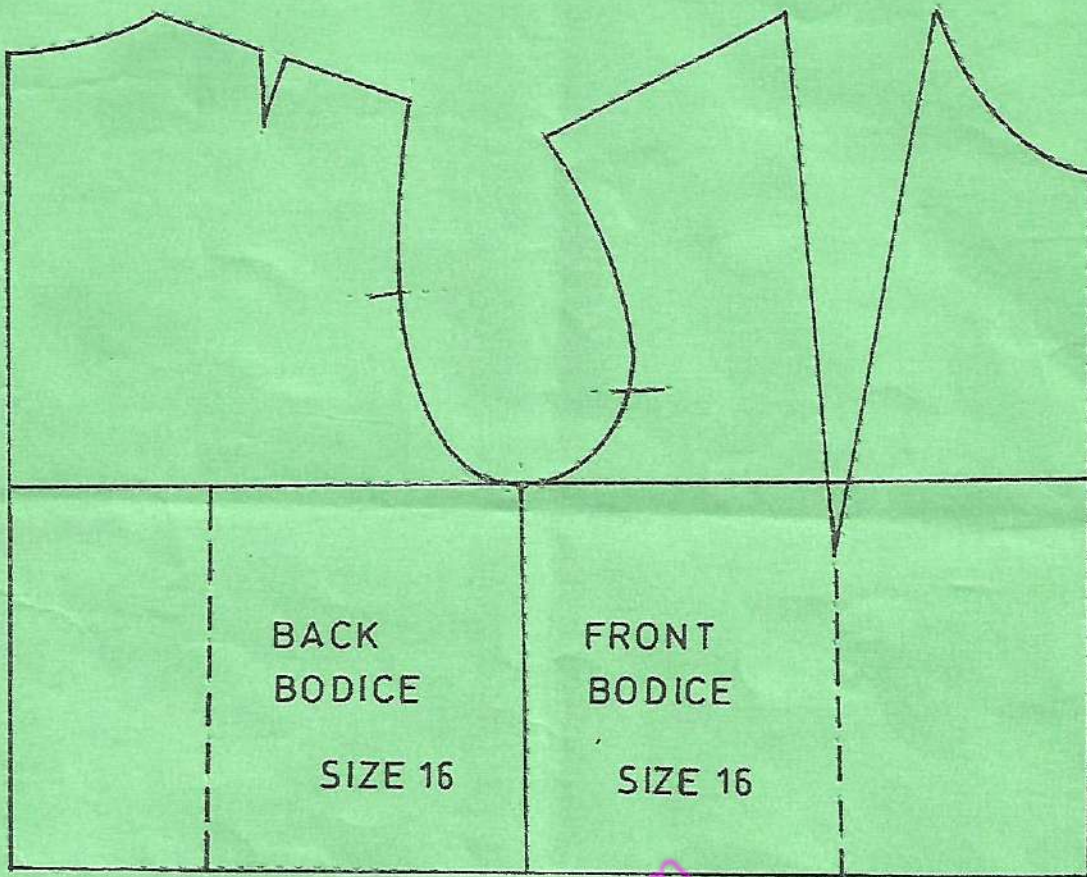
FRONT VIEW
