1. Using the measurements provided, draft the tailored skirt block in $\frac{1}{4}$ scale. (36 marks)

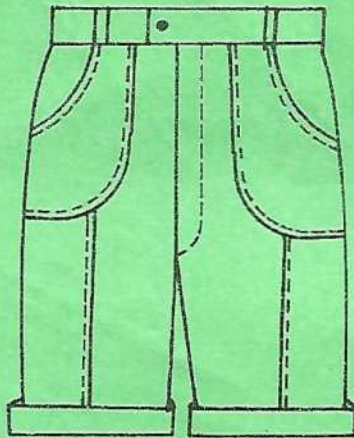
Measurements

Hips	98 cm
Waist to hip	21 cm
Skirt length	65 cm

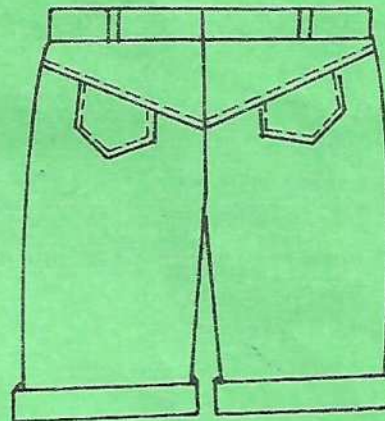
2. Trace out the shorts blocks provided and develop final patterns for the short style sketched below. (74 marks)
