 - (i) plain light weight fabric $1\frac{1}{2}$ metres long by 114 cm wide;
 - (ii) fusible interfacing 30 cm by 24 cm;
 - (iii) thread to match the fabric;
 - (iv) brown papers;
 - (v) one large envelope;
 - (vi) sewing tools.

2. At the end of the examination:
 - (a) stitch on a label bearing your name and index number on a single layer of fabric without concealing any details;
 - (b) enclose the garment in the large envelope provided.

This paper consists of 2 printed pages.

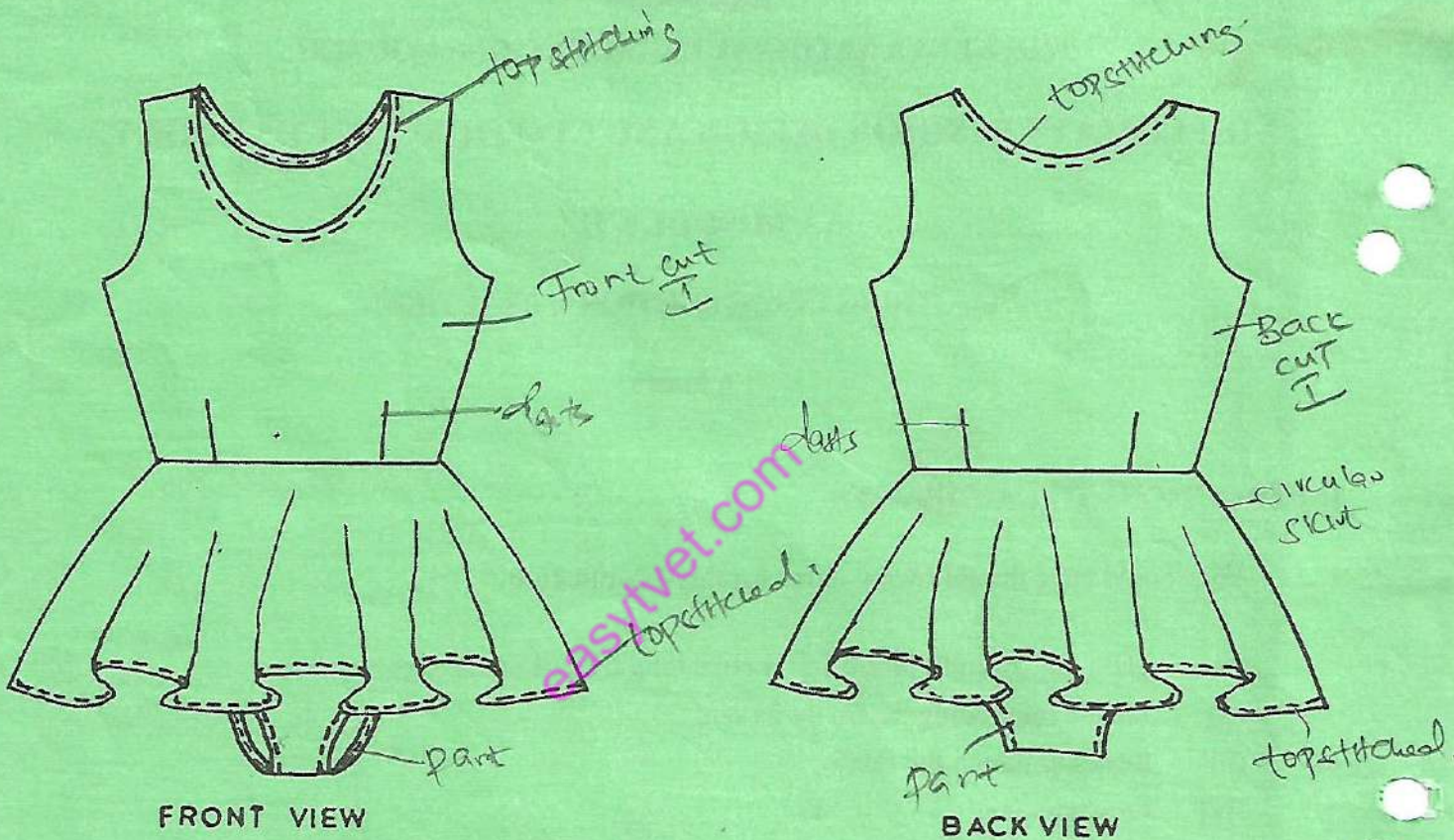
Candidates should check the question paper to ascertain that both pages are printed as indicated and that no questions are missing.

TASKS

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Using the measurements and the materials provided, cut out and make the garment style sketched below as follows:

- (i) use the plain open seam at the shoulders, sides and the pant's sides;
- (ii) finish the neckline with bias;
- (iii) understitch the armhole facings.
