Measurements

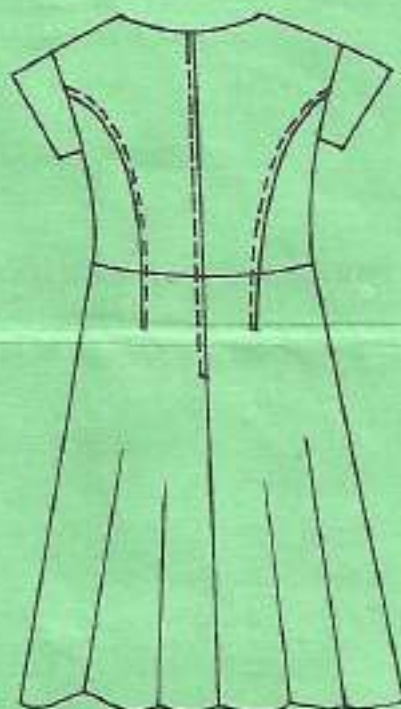
Neck size	-	40 cm

Seye depth	-	24.4 cm
Natural waist length	-	44.6 cm
Half back	-	20 cm
Sleeve length	-	89 cm
Shirt length	-	80 cm
